I have had the pleasure of doing business with Wear-Con for over six years. I was first introduced to them when I was a maintenance manager for a 1 million+ ton cement producer located in the Midwestern U.S. At the time, I was exploring solutions to severe wear problems in a raw mill separator. The air separator served as a dryer/classifier and was fed two-inch minus material. Wear induced mechanical problems were so severe that the separator often became the bottleneck in our process. Though I was sourcing wear plate (chrome carbide and tungsten carbide) at the time, I was immediately taken by Wear-Con's enthusiasm and personal commitment to solving my specific maintenance and operational problems. I found they weren't satisfied with merely supplying wear plate and components. They wanted to understand the complete process and specific wear issues.
